Bring a container-5 gallon buckets work well-lined with a clean garbage bag and half filled with fresh pond water. City water cannot be used. A five gallon container will transport 100 fingerlings, two white Amur, or 300 minnows. When the container is filled by the vendor with fish, oxygen is injected in the bag, and the bag is tied shut for transport.
